## **Garage Sales Regulations**

The regulations in their entirety are contained in Chapter 5.40 of the Municipal Code

- 1. Garage sale means the sale of personal property on any residential property, and includes any yard sale, home sale, patio sale, or any other sale similarly conducted on any residentially zoned or residentially occupied property.
- 2. Not more than two (2) Garage Sales are allowed during any 12 consecutive months.
- 3. The garage sale cannot be held for more than three (3) consecutive days.
- 4. No sale can be held between the hours of 8:00 p.m. of any one day and 8:00 a.m. of the following day.
- 5. No property may be displayed or stored on the sidewalk or public right-of-way.
- 6. No signs shall be displayed on trees, fences, utility boxes, utility poles or light poles.
- 7. The Garage Sale permit **MUST BE POSTED** openly for inspection.

## **On-Site Garage Sales Sign Regulations**

The regulations in their entirety are contained in Section 18.80.160.A & B of Chapter 18.80 of the Municipal Code

1. One sign may be temporarily displayed on the private residential property and the property of other parties with the permission of the owner for up to 72 hours during the garage sale.

The sign must be removed within 24 hours after the sale has ended.

## **Off-Site Garage Sales Sign Regulations**

The regulations in their entirety are contained in Section 18.80.050.D of Chapter 18.80 of the Municipal Code

- 1. A separate \$50 Temporary Off-site Sign Application can be obtained to post directional garage sale signs in the City's right of way from the Planning Department.
- 2. Acceptable garage sale signs are shown on the Temporary Off-site Sign Application.
- 3. Such signs are temporary and:
  - a. Shall not be placed on utility poles, light or traffic light poles, traffic signs or traffic sign poles, street trees or fences.
  - b. Shall not be permanently placed in the public right-of-way, but may be anchored down to prevent them from falling or being blown into the street or sidewalk.
  - c. May only be placed on the public right-of-way Thursday through Sunday during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
  - d. Shall only be placed in landscaped parkways, and shall not be placed on the sidewalk or in the center street median.
  - e. No more than 25 signs may be temporarily placed in the public right-of-way at any one time.
  - f. The sign area shall be no larger 4 square feet and no taller than 3 feet.
  - g. No signs shall obstruct traffic signs, public directional signs, parking signs, and street address signs.
  - h. All Sidewalks and driveways shall be kept clear.
  - i. Signs shall not be illuminated, have flashing lights, have moving parts or generate sounds, or release steam or smoke.
